MEDICAL FORMS:

Many of you have already returned the medical form, but if you have not, please do so prior to camp. **Campers will not be allowed on the bus or up at camp without a completed medical form.** Please send this form to the Cathedral, attention CAMP.

BUS SCHEDULE:

Session I

Depart: Sunday, July 19th Campers should arrive at church by 10:00am, bus will leave at 10:30am. Please meet at the parking lot directly across from the St. Sophia Cathedral, on the west side of Normandie.

Return: Saturday, July 25th @ 4:00pm to Cathedral parking lot

Session II

Depart: Saturday, July 25th Campers should arrive by 10:00am bus will leave at 10:30am. Please meet at the parking lot directly across from the St. Sophia Cathedral, on the west side of Normandie.

Return: Saturday, August 1st 1:00 pm to the Cathedral parking lot

CAMPERS THAT ARE DRIVING TO AND FROM CAMP:

Session I

Drop off time: Sunday, July 19th , no earlier than 11:00 am and no later 1:00 pm

Pick up time: Saturday, July 25th , no later than 2:00 pm

***There is an Open House & BBQ on July 25th for campers and their families. (11:00am–3:00pm)**

Session II

Drop off time: Saturday, July 25th, no earlier than 11:00 am and no later 1:00 pm

Pick up time: Saturday, August 1st, before 12:00pm

CABIN GROUPING:

Parents, please be advised that campers will be placed in an age appropriate group within the guidelines established by the Camp Committee. Attempts will be made to honor parents' requests for their child's placement with **one other friend**. We will not place a child down with a younger group or up with an older group.

VISITATIONS/COMMUNICATION

The Camp Committee does not encourage spontaneous visits of camper's parents or friends. Visitations **MUST BE APPROVED** in advance by the Camp Director.

We ask your cooperation in limiting calls to your child to those that are an **emergency or absolutely necessary**. We appreciate your cooperation in this matter. Cell phones and pagers are not allowed at camp.
